2010 SUMMER PLAYGROUND PROGRAM INFO AND SCHEDULE

Thank you for registering your child for the 2010 Summer Playground Program. This information sheet is designed to help you understand the Summer Playground Program. A better understanding of our program will make for a very enjoyable summer for the children, parents, and Clarksville Parks Department staff.

- ☉ The program is designed for area children going into 2nd – 8th grade. Due to our limited staff, we will be unable to accommodate groups.
- ☉ A school bus will pick up children at GRC, Greenacres, and Parkwood schools and take the children to Lapping Park, Colgate Park, or to the field trip destination. The bus will return children to the schools after the program. A playground leader will be at each bus stop. Thank you in advance for being prompt when picking up your child.
- ☉ For safety purposes, children **MUST** ride the bus to and from all activities. **No late comers or drop-offs permitted.**
- ☉ Each child will be given a Clarksville Parks Dept Summer Playground T-Shirt that they will be required to wear on ALL field trips.
- ☉ In order to be eligible to attend the field trips (including Holiday World) and the Clarksville Aquatic Center, children must attend the majority of the program.
- ☉ Children are permitted and encouraged to bring extra spending money on the field trips.
- ☉ Unless otherwise noted on the schedule, a lunch period will not be provided; therefore, we ask children to eat *before* attending the program. The majority of the program will take place outside, so please send a drink with your child.
- ☉ The Playground Program will not take place during inclement weather; therefore, the events are subject to change. An effort will be made to make up special events. **The park does shut down during inclement weather.** Thank you in advance for immediately coming to pick up your child if this is to occur. **A bus will NOT return children to the schools!**
- ☉ Children will be notified on Thursday of any changes for the following week.
- ☉ We, at the Clarksville Parks, do have a disciplinary policy in place to ensure a fun, safe environment for children enrolled in the program and its staff. Please contact the Parks Office for more details regarding this policy.
- ☉ Our Summer Playground Program staff will be working hard to make this an enjoyable program for your child. Please take the time to introduce yourself and familiarize yourself with our staff.
